Sikorsky celebrates 10,000 hour aircraft with donation to That Others May Live

Albuquerque, NM

Tuesday, 30 August 2011 marked a notable achievement for two HH-60G Pave Hawk Helicopters manufactured by Sikorsky Aircraft Corporation. The stalwart aircraft is routinely used in United States Air Force combat search and rescue training and operational missions both in civilian and military scenarios. The two aircraft reached the 10,000 hour mark of use and Sikorsky commemorated the event with a donation in the amount of \$10,000 to That Others May Live Foundation (TOML), a non-profit charitable organization that provides post-secondary educational assistance to the children of Fallen USAF Rescue Heroes as well as other aid to the rescue families.

Sikorsky Aircraft Corporation, Director for Air Force Programs, Tim Healy, marked the occasion at Kirtland Air Force Base on Tuesday and stated, "This milestone puts an exclamation point on what has been an incredible 50 year partnership for our nation, AF Rescue and Sikorsky Aircraft. Igor Sikorsky himself was an enormous fan of the then, Air Rescue Service, the forerunner to today's AF Combat Rescue forces. Sikorsky said that these Airmen, **"have contributed "one of the most glorious pages in the history of human flight."** I couldn't agree more, the incredible operators and maintainers of today's HH-60G force bring to life Igor Sikorsky's dream to create the most prolific life-saving machine man had ever seen."

Healy continued, "Today's celebration is also very personal for me, as I was blessed to fly on both of these aircraft with some amazing crewmembers who have since paid the ultimate price for our freedom. So, I can think of no better way for Sikorsky to honor them by commemorating this occasion with a gift to TOML which will directly benefit their children and the warriors who continue their fine tradition."

Within the 2010-2011 academic school year the TOML Foundation has provided nearly \$30,000 in scholarships and immediate tragedy assistance and wounded warrior assistance to USAF Rescue Heroes as well as the families of those Killed In Action from the USAF Rescue Forces. The Board of Directors for TOML Foundation has also approved nearly \$21,000 in assistance for the 2011-2012 academic school year. The TOML Foundation has assisted two surviving children graduate from college and is assisting four currently enrolled in college. Numerous additional children, who are not yet of age, are within the pipeline for assistance when they are ready to attend college.
