One of the highlights of sponsoring the Rescue Ball at Moody AFB was the privilege to witness Big. Gen. Eugene Haase award Bronze Star Medals with Valor to Staff Sgt. Mark Bedell, 38th Rescue Squadron Pararescueman and Staff Sgt. Mark McHan, 38th Rescue Squadron Pararescueman. Capt. Evan Roth, 41st Rescue Squadron pilot was awarded the Air Medal with Valor at the Rescue Ball making the evening a truly spirited occasion where rescue accomplishments could be celebrated by everyone.
