That Others May Live Foundation Now Providing Immediate Tragedy Assistance

That Others May Live Foundation (TOML) announces the launch of its Immediate Tragedy Assistance Program. TOML Foundation, a 501(c)3 non-profit charitable organization, has recently changed its mission in order to accommodate the needs of families who have encountered tragedies within the United States Air Force (USAF) Combat Search and Rescue career fields.

According to the Foundation's Executive Director, Lt. Col. Jim McElhenney, USAF (ret), "Recent world events have created a need for the population we serve. Not only will we continue to augment the needs of the children of Fallen USAF Rescue Heroes with their post-secondary educational needs, we are now able to assist with the immediate needs of the families following a tragedy." With regard to the recent Chinook H-47 tragedy, claiming 30 lives, families are forced to drop everything on a moment's notice and the Foundation has been able to provide assistance as well as determine the long-term needs where future assistance may be provided.

Within the 2010-2011 academic school year the TOML Foundation has provided over \$25,000 in scholarship and immediate tragedy assistance to Wounded In Action USAF Rescue Heroes as well as the families of those Killed In Action from the USAF Rescue Forces. The Foundation has assisted two surviving children graduate from college and is assisting four currently enrolled in college. Numerous additional children, who are not yet of age, are within the pipeline for assistance when they are ready to attend college.
