Rescue personnel deploy worldwide from Moody Air Force Base, home to the 23rd Wing which also comprises two geographically detached units at Davis Monthan AFB in Tucson, AZ and Nellis AFB in Las Vegas, NV. That Others May Live Foundation is not endorsed by the US Air Force or Department of Defense and receives no federal funding. Donations to the Foundation are tax deductible.
